

Scholarship Application Instructions

The membership of the Greater Fairfield Board of Realtors, INC provides a program of scholarship awards to deserving students. This scholarship program is made available through generous contributions received from its membership.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

Students must be a resident of Fairfield and currently enrolled as a **senior** in any accredited high school **in the United States.**

Exception: Any child/grandchild/stepchild/ or child whose Guardian is a primary member of GFBOR is eligible to apply, regardless of place of residence or high school. (Guardians must provide documentation).

APPLYING FOR AWARDS

We require that the following items be completed and submitted no later than May 1, 2023. This is a fillable pdf form, or you may choose to hand write your answers on any of the following. Each page must be printed, and hand signed. Pages may be returned by scanned e mail, hand delivery or through post office delivery.

- The complete three-page application
- The Transcript and College Board SAT Scores Request, completed by the candidate and delivered (electronically or in person) to the high school record office.
- The Confirmation Form I outlines how to include a copy of your Admissions/Financial Aid Package. This information is required.
- The Confirmation Form II is to be completed by the candidate and delivered to the College, University or Vocational school in which you plan to enroll.
- The Guidance Counselor Recommendation Form must be delivered to your High School Guidance Counselor and returned to the Greater Fairfield Board of Realtors (electronically, by mail or in person) with his/her letter of recommendation.
- The Second Recommendation Form must be delivered to the person writing a letter of recommendation and returned to the Greater Fairfield Board of Realtors (electronically, by mail or in person).

To make the final allocation of available awards, the trustees of the fund will review all applicant information, including cumulative grades, SAT scores, class ranking, scholastic activities, letters of recommendation and other indicators of potential success. Note: The selection of recipient(s) is not based in any way on race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, any handicap, sexual orientation or gender identity.

There will be three \$1,000 scholarships available in 2023.

Notification to award recipients is made in June. The awards in turn, are disbursed annually and are sent directly to recipients.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.
